POSITION SUMMARY:

Operate and maintains equipment and tools for minor construction projects, inspection of playground and park equipment via Certified Playground Safety Inspection (CPSI) standards; and performs general maintenance tasks in area of assigned responsibility.

- Landscaping and facilities maintenance including, but not limited to, mowing, weed eating, and edging.
- Conduct routine and annual inspection of playgrounds and park equipment according to CPSI standards and established guidelines
- Maintain and repair playground areas and play equipment according to CPSI standards and established guidelines.
- Performs trash pick-up and playground maintenance in assigned area of responsibility.
- Utilize carpentry, welding and other construction tools and equipment to build and maintain park amenities.
- Performs vehicle, equipment, and tool maintenance for work assignments.
- Supports other divisions with special events and projects as needed.
- Performs all other related duties as assigned.
